

CR Note: The COVID-19 pandemic has made air purification a **"Buyer Beware" market.** Research is needed to verify ability of devices to remove or deactivate microbes within aerosols in the clinical environment. CR is currently evaluating numerous air purification devices and concepts.

Management of airborne microbes should start at: 1) oral cavity, 2) clinician's body, and 3) office entries. Use the 8 steps easily available to all office teams (see Clinicians Report August 2020) and then extend to adjunct products that treat ambient air. No one device, method, or step SOLVES the problem; a combination approach is needed. Correct angulation and use of HVE reduces aerosols significantly.
