- 1. Product evaluation among 450 actively practicing dentists as clinical evaluators in their own offices worldwide
- 2. Basic science laboratory testing in CR's extensive facilities and the CR University of Utah Dental Test Clinic
- 3. Controlled long-term clinical research completed by TRAC Research, the human studies section of CR



CR Note: Aerosols ejected during active cutting at speeds up to 70 mph create a "bubble" of concentrated patient oral debris around the oral cavity in a zone occupied by the dentist and dental assistant. The most thorough solution was the effective use of high velocity evacuation (HVE, suction horizontal to occlusal plane), personal protective equipment (PPE), and surface disinfection combined with a powerful overhead downdraft fan HEPA filter to clear clinicians' breathing zone.



CR Note: Conservative periodontal treatment can be as effective as periodontal surgery. This includes: 1) education, 2) tongue cleaning, 3) 2-to-3-month scaling and root planing, 4) sub-systemic antibiotics, 5) oral rinses, and 6) local antibiotics. However, **conservative periodontal treatment requires excellent patient compliance and thorough practitioner follow-up**.

CR Note: A combination of ibuprofen (400–600mg) and acetaminophen (500mg) every 6 hours provides effective pain relief comparable to opioids **without the complications or dangers of opioids**. Combining analgesics that work differently provides more pain relief than a single analgesic can on its own.


